This beautiful cottage was originally built for the last Ferryman - Mr John Mollineaux. Mr Mollineaux rowed passengers across the Derwent until his death in 1952. He built his home directly opposite the cottage of James Austin, the very first Ferryman, who officially started the service in 1818. James Austin was an important part of connecting the northern and southern parts of the state before the Bridgewater bridge was built and the cottage itself is the oldest remaining cottage of its kind in Australia.

Located in a picturesque and private location within the heart of Austins Ferry, sits this charming two-bedroom, one-bathroom character cottage, originally built in 1923!! Cosmetic renovations have been completed over the years whilst still keeping in touch with this much loved era.
